A panel of three adjudicators viewed student choreography and performances at the National Festival and chose students to receive each award. Panelists Dana Tai Soon Burgess, Jennifer Stahl and Lisa Traiger chose the following recipients for these awards:

AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING STUDENT CHOREOGRAPHY:

fourtold, choreography by Alfonso Cervera, Irvin Gonzalez, Hyoin Jun, and Maggie Sniffen - University of California, Riverside

"for the sophistication of its comedic approach to voice and movement style. Comedy in dance is not easy, yet this piece pulled it off very successfully. The humor had a freshness that showed true ingenuity."

Outstanding Student Choreography Honorable Mention:
