Description: One-year Emory Arts Fellowship in Dance and Movement Studies beginning fall We seek an early career dance artist whose work involves creating and performing choreography. 2023. This fellowship is supported through a generous gift from Sarah Arison '07B.

Duties:

- Teach a half load of a typical tenure track faculty member (7.5 hours studio contact hours per semester), including choreographing on student dancers in the Fall of 2023.
- Other teaching could include technique of any dance form, movement improvisation, somatic practice, repertory, or creative practice.
- All teaching is in person.
- Maintain a robust campus presence.
- Engage with arts events and students for the 2023/24 academic year.
- The fellow will be expected to present a choreographic or performance project.

Qualifications: Required: A BA in dance or a (highly-preferred) MFA in dance or related appropriate field. Other degrees, training, and/or appropriate experience will be considered as additional qualifications for this fellowship.

Compensation: \$45,000 salary, health benefits, research funds, and support for a presentation of a choreographic or performance project, (Spring 2024).
